



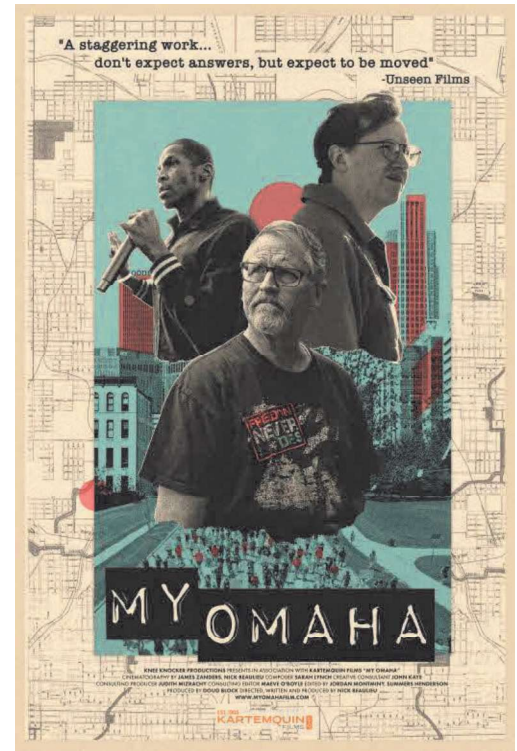
Diversity Days in La Grange
